Maintenance Level - TV - TVW Increase In Viewership

Agency Recommendation Summary

Substantial increases to viewership are driving increased costs including broadband, increased coverage, digital storage and more. Without supplemental funding, by necessity, TVW will be forced to reduce the level of service to the state of Washington. This could include, but is not limited to, a return to the "television only" model, a reduction in events covered, and other significant reductions to gavel-to-gavel coverage. TVW needs the state's partnership to continue providing the level of service the citizens of our state have come to expect from TVW.

Decision Package Description

TVW is requesting a "case load" supplement of \$2,000,000 to manage increased costs so they can continue their duty to produce gavel to gavel coverage of state government deliberations as well as archive and maintain those resources to make them accessible to the legal community, legislative staff, state agency leaders, boards and commissions and citizens from around our state and the world for research purposes. TVW's substantial increase in viewership is driving increased broadband as well as coverage and digital storage costs (including costs associated with storage). Increases to the minimum wage for exempt employees anticipated in 2024 would increase staffing costs. Without this supplement, TVW would be forced to reduce its level of service to the state of Washington, which could include, but is not limited to, a return to the "television only" offerings, a reduction in events covered and other significant reductions to our gavel-to-gavel coverage. TVW is now covering as many as 50 events day during the legislative session and those 50 events garner as many as 10,000 or more live views. TVW collects and archives up to 4,000 hours of original content each year that is vital to community stakeholders. Without this supplemental funding TVW will be unable to maintain this level of service the citizens of the state of Washington have come to expect from TVW.
